

State College Fly Fishing Trip May 14-17



This year, we will return to central Pennsylvania to fish the famous limestone streams of the Nittany Valley. This is going to be a fantastic trip, planned for both beginners and experts (and anyone in between), ***the main goal here is to get away and have some fun!***

THURSDAY • MAY 14TH “STEAK & ALE”

Leave in groups from the club (meet 2:00, back parking lot) by member-driven Suburbans, Tahoes, Vans, etc... head to the Penn State area. Just outside the town of Potters Mills, we have secured for our exclusive use, a large sportsman's lodge (Mountain Acres) that will comfortably accommodate up to 30 guys. This lodge will allow everyone to stay at the same location and is complete with a large kitchen, great room, pool table, stocked trout pond, bar, fireplace and modern plumbing. The accommodations are typical "lodge style" with multiple bedrooms, complete with single cots and bunk beds. Please bring your own towels, pillow and bedding (sleeping bag).

- **Thursday night, we will start the weekend off with professional fly fishing instruction (casting, fly-fishing techniques, etc...) on the lodge's stocked trout pond, followed by a steak & ale dinner. Cocktails and cards to follow. We have locked down the best guide service in the area for our use. Local guides will be on-hand Thursday night and all-day Friday to provide instruction and guide us about the area streams.**

FRIDAY • MAY 15TH “SEAFOOD NIGHT”

Breakfast at the lodge. Meet up with the guides at TCO Fly Shop (Penn State's Orvis® Store) for all-day fly fishing.

Dinner at the lodge. Cocktails, cards and fishing stories to follow.

- **We will have a chance to fish a variety of streams with emphasis on Spring Creek & Penns Creek. Friday, we will break up into small groups according to skill level. The guides will help in seasonal fly selection and will direct us, according to the weather and stream conditions, to the best possible spots. The streams we will be fishing are predominantly catch and release. Friday & Saturday lunch will be on your own - there are plenty of restaurants throughout the area to help break up the day. Throughout the trip, the club will be supplying draft beer, soft drinks and all appropriate mixers. Attendees are asked to bring their own liquor of choice.**

SATURDAY • MAY 16TH “ITALIAN NIGHT”

Breakfast at the lodge. On your own for all-day fly fishing. "On the pond" fishing competition.

Dinner at the lodge. Cocktails, cards and fishing stories to follow.

- **For the 11th year, we've gained access to the Mountain Acres sporting clays range and have an afternoon shooting competition planned. Bring your shotguns and ammo - the club will supply the clay pigeons.**

SUNDAY • MAY 17TH

Breakfast at the lodge. After clean-up, plan to return early in the morning.
